



2020 APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & GENERAL INFORMATION

The Waxahachie Downtown Farmers Market is located at 410 S. Rogers Street. The regular market season will begin on Saturday, April 25th. The market typically goes to the end of October but a project taking place in that area may cause the market to cease operations before that date. Market hours are from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. An organizational meeting has been scheduled for **Tuesday, March 31st at 5:30 pm**. The meeting will take place at City Hall, 401 S. Rogers Street, Waxahachie in the Council Chambers. Vendors will be able to tour the market area, turn in paperwork and fees, and ask questions at this meeting. *Potential vendors are strongly encouraged to attend this meeting if at all possible.*

Please make sure you read the Rules and Regulations thoroughly before submitting an application. All vendors must complete and submit:

- Waxahachie Downtown Farmers Market Vendor Application
- COW Temporary Food Establishment Permit Application
- Indemnity Agreement

Food vendors (not including produce) must also complete and submit:

- Merchandise labels and other requirements for “cottage food” vendors if applicable
- Any required licenses, permits, or other documents as needed by the Health Department
