

How to search the floodplain location in the FEMA Website

Step 1:

Go to the website: <https://msc.fema.gov/>




Image 1 – FEMA Flood Map Service Center webpage

Step 2:

Enter the “Address under the Looking for a Flood Map?”




Image 2 – Search by Address Page

Use the mouse roller to zoom to the location you want to check the floodplain location, use measure tools or modify the search location based on address




Image 4 – Map after zooming into an area of interest

Base Flood Elevation for the 1% Annual Chance Floodplain


Blue Outline - Approved Letter of Map Revision (LOMR)
