On motion of Alderman Mizell seconded by Alderman Oldham, the following Ordinance was passed on first reading.

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ISSUANCE AND EXHIBITION OF HEALTH CERTIFICATES IN THE CITY OF WAXAHACHIE, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

On motion of Alderman Oldham seconded by Alderman Willis, the following resolution was passed.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, whereas, the City Council of the City of Waxahachie, after having made a thorough examination and investigation of the physical condition of Cantrell Street, Bullard Heights Addition to the City of Waxahachie, is of the opinion and finds that said street is in a bad state of repair, and

Whereas, said street constitutes the main artery of traffic to the CCC Camp, and trade territory in the Southwestern part of Ellis County, Texas, and

Whereas, the Commissioners' Court of Ellis County, has agreed to participate with the City in repairing said street, to the extent of One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars, cash, and all available equipment, and

Whereas, the City Council heretofore passed a resolution, on to wit, July 5, 1938, with reference to this matter, which resolution is superceded by this resolution.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Waxahachie, that the resolution heretofore adopted on, to wit, July 5, 1938, be in all things repealed.

Be it further resolved by the City Council in regular session assembled that the City of Waxahachie agree to sponsor said project, at a cost to City not to exceed \$1700.00, and to accept the contribution from the County of Ellis, and the Street Committee be authorized to execute on behalf of the City all necessary contracts, and agreements, relative to the repavement of said Cantrell Street
