The meeting was called to hear protest of interested property owners, residing in the vicinity of Block 28, Williams Addition to the City of Waxahachie, against the proposed erection of a Tourist Hotel and Filling station on a part of said block, which location was classed as a Local Retail District by recommendation of the Board of Adjustment of the City of Waxahachie and passed by the Council in November 1938.

After considerable discussion, it was decided that immediate relief could not be legally given by the Council and in order that the meeting of the above named property owners could be continued, the Council adjourned to the City Hall Office to transact other business of the session.


In the matter of lower water and sewer rates under discussion at a prior meeting, the Council on motion of Alderman Lasswell, seconded by Alderman Oldham, voted unanimously to make the Housing Authority of the City of Waxahachie a flat rate of 15 cents per thousand gallons of water per month and to make a monthly sewer service charge of 25¢ per building, also if a contract approved by the Finance Committee was made, the City would allow the electric service charge of the Housing Authority of Waxahachie, to be figured in the City's monthly bills from the Electric Service Company, such charges to be paid to the City of Waxahachie as provided by aforesaid contract.

On motion of Alderman Lasswell, seconded by Alderman Parks, Tax Collector O'Bannion was instructed to figure the delinquent taxes on the T.M. Rockett property, being part of block 27, T.A. on a valuation of \$1800.00, provided immediate payment is made.
